We were delighted when the Worshipful Company of Glass Sellers, for which David Wilkinson is a Liveryman, decided to use an image of a chandelier that we manufactured in 1993/4 on the front of their Christmas card this year – see left.

The chandelier that is cleverly pictured from below by photographer Karla Gowlett, is one of a pair that are located in the North and South Drawing Rooms of Mansion House in the City of London.

The chandeliers are a tent and waterfall style and were designed based on a famous 1828 design by John Blades (c 1751 – 1829), who was a Liveryman of the Company himself, being appointed Cut Glass Manufacturer to his Majesty, George III in 1789. Each chandelier contains 4,500 pieces of hand cut crystal and weighs 100kg. The pair took 6 months to manufacture.
